Under the project RAS/6/029 "Distance Assisted Training in Nuclear Medicine (DAT)", a harmonise training syllabus and course material which has improved the delivery mechanisms and helped tailor the course to suit the professional development programmes of all nuclear medicine specialities was established. Furthermore, a website was developed for the delivery of DAT on-line (DATOL) which offers a new and unique benchmark for assessed competency based standards which enables the harmonization of global training in Nuclear Medicine & PET for which no alternative form of training currently exists. In parallel, the project trained National DAT programme Coordinators on how to utilize DATOL for in-country program implementation in addition to training Member States staff for tutoring and extended utilisation of DATOL. As MS interest in DATOL increased, the next TC project RAS/6/064 was initiated to update the training material and adapt the website facility to accommodate translated materials and support additional regional complementary resources.</p> <p>DATOL is a harmonised, web-based, distance learning programmed and a formal vocational training for nuclear medicine professionals. It is the result of a joint initiative between the IAEA and the University of Sydney and has been greatly benefitted from the close cooperation of the University in the development process. In addition, the success of DATOL development is also credited to the nuclear medicine professionals from Member States.</p> <p>Project Outputs:</p> <p>The Agency has provided a number of international experts to the Philippines, Thailand, Malaysia, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, China and Vietnam over the course of 2012 – 2013 where additional guidance were provided towards National coordination so that the individual countries can take more responsibility to drive their National DAT programme. These missions were successful in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Training of more MS users for in-country management of DAT-OL facilities including website structure and management, tutor roles and activities, use of country webpage, among others- Overview of current DATOL status through SWOT analysis of visited countries- Better adaptation of materials for multidisciplinary use and local needs- Strengthened National Coordination and team management- Practical assessment advice was provided- DAT-OL local implementation problems were assessed and addressed- Encouragement of High Education Institutions (HEI) involvement to make DAT-OL an official Diploma course

In addition, an expert mission was held in Austria regarding the improvement and extended training resources adapted to regional need available on-line. The mission was successful in

- Refining, updating and integrating the DATOL training materials.
- Making the DATOL materials available in local languages.
- Manage and operate the DATOL website to be responsive and meet the required training needs and maintain its currency.

The final meeting held in April 2014 in Austria was a review of the effectiveness of the project management and coordination at both regional and national level. The two main agenda for the meeting were i) Implementing DATOL through Human Health Campus (HHC) and ii) Discussing and finalising the report on the project (RAS/6/064)

Project Outcomes:

The key achievement of the project is that RCA MS have successfully adopted the DAT-OL as a comprehensive training program for nuclear medicine technologists and specialized provisions for other nuclear medicine professionals.

Remarks:

In order to ensure the continued updating and relevance of the training material the Agency should consider ways in which the currently available material can be periodically reviewed.

The overall project has been successful with the launch of DATOL website on 25 September 2014 through the Agency's HHC with open and student access modalities. Its success can be seen by the way that utilization of DATOL is maximized and the training is adopted both in more number of Member States.
