Background Over the past two decades regional radiation protection projects have focussed on establishing and maintaining basic radiation protection infrastructures. This |

included the establishment of radiation protection legislation and regulation, occupational exposure control, medical (patient) exposure control, public exposure control and emergency planning and preparedness. The current and former RCA and IAEA radiation protection projects have borne fruit and radiation protection infrastructure now exists and continues to be developed in all Member States in the region in varying degrees of sophistication. This RCA project RAS9042 looked ahead to the future and sustaining what has achieved to date, through the development of action plans for sustainability, ongoing regional networking and exchange of information and continued mutual support of our regional radiation protection endeavours. The project has four components covering regulatory infrastructure (including public exposure control), occupational exposure control, medical (patient) exposure control, and radiological emergency preparedness and response.

Project Outputs (Required):

17 regional events including technical meetings, field exercises and project coordination meetings were successfully conducted. Four radiation protection networks were established as means of infrastructures to ensure the self-sustainability and regional self-reliance of the participating countries beyond 2010. These included: 1) ARAN (Asia Region ALARA Network on Occupational Exposure), 2) Medical Network for Cardiologists in Radiation Protection, 3) Regional Forum for Regulators, and 4) Emergency Response Network for Radiological Emergency Planning and Preparedness. Each network actively held technical meetings and/or training courses for establishing its own network for making sure of the sustainable future activities in its field. Publication was published periodically to share experience and exchange of information. A total of 28 people from the region directly benefitted from the regional events especially in the regional training courses on field exercise organized by the project

Project Outcome (Required):

The support provided by the TC/RCA project has helped to enhance technical capacities at the national and regional level. All the networks established under the project are being maintained by the member states themselves. The networks established action plans and arranged various mechanisms to maintain sustainability of the networks after the TC project was over: a) regulatory infrastructure and public exposure control; b) occupational exposure control; c) medical exposure control; and d) emergency planning preparedness.

Asia Region ALARA Network (ARAN) has been successful, with useful and appropriate range of activities. The overall impact had been of beneficial assistance to all participating member states. At the project Final Review Meeting, the member states have agreed on a mechanism to improve coordination among the network members, and national focal points would be appointed. It was also agreed that the member states would utilize their own resources to sustaining the cooperation after completion of the RCA project. Specifically, an action plan for the period 2012/13 was adopted for regional sustainability in occupational exposure which includes all types of civilian practices within the different sectors: nuclear, industrial, medical, research, and naturally occurring radioactive materials (NORM), and scrap material. The national institute of radiological sciences (NIRS) of Japan is hosting the network web-site in accordance with the action plan. The network will produce an introductory brochure for wide circulation giving objectives and activities planned.

Medical Network. A specific action plan was adopted, which included a launching of a newsletter, which by known accounts in the very first newsletter on radiation protection in cardiology of any cardiology organization. Nine issues of the newsletter have been published and copies have been distributed among the RCA Member States. The newsletter is available at the IAEA Radiation Protection for Patients web site:

Eleven RCA member states are actively participating in disseminating the knowledge on radiation protection in the region by giving lectures, organizing live sessions and organizing sessions in cardiology conferences. The network is extending its activities through collaboration with interventional cardiologists from other regions such as Latin America and Eastern Europe. It had exceeded all expectations and achieved impact and recognition beyond the RCA programme. The network will continue to publish its newsletter and carry out activities to strengthen the networking with minimum financial support from the Agency.

Regulatory Network. The Regulatory Network had been successful, with useful and appropriate range of activities implemented. The overall impact had been of beneficial assistance to all participating member states. The member states at the Final Project Review meeting concluded that it was still too soon to expect that regional sustainability of the complex areas of Regulatory Network to have been achieved at this early stage. An action plan was agreed for the period 2012/2013 and this would be undertaken using national resources. Some of the aspects of the past project implementation were identified as requiring improvement, such as the effective and timely follow up of actions and measure. Strategies have been agreed to provide clearer definitions of responsibilities and accountability, which will assist in correcting causes of the implementational inefficiencies. A web site for the Regulatory Network is going to be developed in collaboration with IAEA under the IAEA's Global Nuclear Safety and Security Network

Emergency Response Network. The project component had been successful. The overall impact had been of beneficial assistance to all participating member states. At the Final Meeting, it was concluded that it was too soon to expect that regional sustainability in the complex area of radiological emergency planning and preparedness to have been achieved at this early stage. There was a need to continue an agreed range of project initiative to build on the successes achieved to date and to build up to the goal of regional sustainability. An action plan was agreed for the period 2012/13 and this would be undertaken using national resources. Forum for enhanced decision making for radiation emergency management was formed for emergency responders. Field exercises and a discussion exercise on the radiological emergency improved capabilities of member countries for preparedness, response, management and decision-making of nuclear and radiological emergencies. The Emergency Response Network adopted terms of reference and the action plan. The web-site hosted by Bangladesh was identified as a platform for exchange of information and demonstrated at the Final Project Review Meeting.
